The Los Angeles Unified School District seeks an outstanding Instructional Specialist to lead the students, staff and community at San Pedro High School towards improved academic success.

San Pedro High School is a single track traditional school serving approximately 3,000 students in grades 9-12. The school is located at 1001 W. 15<sup>th</sup> Street, San Pedro, CA 90731.

**The Ideal Candidate** has the ability to work as a dynamic instructional leader with strong interpersonal skills and can work with all stakeholders to create a strong culture of collaboration and high expectations for all students. The candidate should have successful experience in school improvement, RtII standards-based instruction, and the ability to lead the staff in the effective use of data to inform instruction.

### Required Experience:

- Five years of successful full-time public school certificated service
- Three years experience as a teacher in a K-12 public school program
- Two years experience at a middle or senior high school, grades 6-12
- At least one year of verifiable non-classroom leadership experience, such as coordinator, instructional coach, dean, etc.

### Minimum Requirements include:

- A valid California K-12 Teaching Credential
- Master's degree from an accredited college or university
- Multicultural coursework\*
- District Master Plan requirements\*

*\*Out-of-District candidates have one year to complete this requirement*
