Elementary Teachers Have You Considered Secondary?

Credentialed Multiple Subject Teachers Are Needed in our Secondary Schools

The hiring needs for LAUSD lie at the secondary level, grades 7-12, specifically in the areas of mathematics, chemistry, physics, and biological science. Teachers with Multiple Subject Credentials may wish to consider teaching middle or high school. By verifying subject-matter competence in a specialty area and taking one Secondary Methods class, you can earn a Single Subject Teaching Credential in the State of California. Subject-matter competence can be verified in one of three ways:

- (1) achieve a passing score on the appropriate subject-matter examination (CSET),
- (2) complete a Commission-approved subject-matter program, or its equivalent, and obtain verification from the California college or university with an approved subject matter program, or
- (3) for specialized biological science only, individuals may take and pass the appropriate subject matter examinations or obtain verification of completion of subject-matter course work from the Commission on Teacher Credentialing.

This option is available to teachers who already possess a valid Multiple Subject Teaching Credential issued by the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing.
