Selection Requirements

- 🍏 A minimum 2.75 grade point average
- 🍏 Commitment to working as an Apprentice Teacher

Program Requirements

- 🍏 Pursuing an Educational Specialist Credential or a Single Subject Teaching Credential in Foundational -Level-Mathematics
- 🍏 Work as a credentialed teacher for LAUSD at a high needs school for each year of participation in the program
